1. About Pragjyotishpur University

1.1. THE SPONSORING BODY: SERF



The Shankardev Education and Research Foundation (SERF) is a trust formally established on Sunday, the 22nd of August 2021, at Guwahati, Assam. It is a voluntary organisation that envisions quality higher education along with inculcation of the sense of Bharatiya life values in students. The SERF aims to work on two fronts for realising its objectives:

1. Developing educational institutions.
2. Collaborating with educational institutions.

As a part of its first objective, Pragjyotishpur University has come into being with the enactment of the Pragjyotishpur University Act No. XLVI of 2022 by the Government of Assam. Today, the SERF is the Sponsoring Body of the University.

Immediately after its establishment, the SERF, taking a step towards its second objective, conducted a series of academic deliberations and knowledge dissemination exercises. The outcome was the Two-Day North-East Education Conclave 2021, which was organised from 20-21 November 2021 at Guwahati Medical College & Hospital Auditorium and at Assam Administrative Staff College, Guwahati. The conclave aimed to illustrate the basic premise of NEP, 2020, its challenges, and experiences related to its implementation in some of the major states in Bharat.

This was the biggest Education Conclave in Northeast Bharat in recent years and was attended by many personalities of note: among them, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma; the Union Minister for Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan; five education ministers from the states of Manipur, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, and Assam; representatives of the Education Ministers of Nagaland, Mizoram, and Tripura; and resource persons from various reputed organisations such as the AICTE, the NCERT, the NCTE, the UGC, IIMs, IITs, Central Universities, colleges, and schools.

Going ahead, the SERF organised the Pragjyotishpur Literature Festival 2023, an extraordinary literary extravaganza held from 29 September-1 October 2023 in Guwahati. The LitFest was aimed at familiarising and bonding the people of Bharat with the rich literary heritage of Northeast Bharat. It was also aimed at giving youth of the region an occasion to tap into and become more aware of their own impressions regarding their roots in their cultures and literary traditions.

1.2. THE UNIVERSITY

The name 'Pragjyotishpur' connotes rays of primordial light and, in ancient times, signified the geographic area that spans much of what is Northeast Bharat today. This name has been mentioned even in texts as old as the *Rāmāyaṇa* and the *Mahābhārata*.

Honouring the rich and vibrant legacy associated with this name, Pragjyotishpur University came into being on Monday, the 17th of October 2022, with the enactment of the Pragjyotishpur University Act No. XLVI of 2022 by the Government of Assam.

Pragjyotishpur University was founded with a resolve to nurture a centre of world-class education and research driven by a cross-cutting approach for overcoming barriers to knowledge creation, sustenance, and dissemination. Each and every corner of this university rings with the rhythm of the true essence of *Jñāna* (knowledge), *Prajñā* (wisdom), and *Satya* (truth), three principles explicitly incorporated in the mandate of the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020. Pragjyotishpur University can accordingly be seen as a seat of learning born out of the NEP, 2020.



1.3. OUR VISION

To create Global Knowledge Leaders for the holistic development of humanity.

1.4. OUR MISSION

To develop individuals with capabilities to be true world leaders: through advanced scholarship, research, and innovation, facilitating a transdisciplinary approach to provide solutions for achieving sustainable goals of advancement.

In line with this mission, Pragjyotishpur University aims to build a State-of-the-Art knowledge repository and create digital infrastructure for expanding the horizons of thought among all stakeholders. The University seeks to achieve these goals by generating an innovative and creative educational ecosystem to foster engagement with Business, Government, and Communities (BGC) for an overall constructive development.

Upholding its mission, the university aims, too, at reinvigorating and nurturing institutional and social relationships across various levels of exchange between Bharat, Southeast Asia, and the world on the basis of implemented policies as envisaged in the NEP, 2020, for the promotion of cultural pride and entrepreneurial spirit.

1.5. OUR VALUES

Creativity, Self-awareness, Social Responsibility, Team Spirit, Humanity, Entrepreneurship, and Inclusiveness.

Pragjyotishpur University echoes the muse of the famous saying of the Gita, invoking the essence of true knowledge by seeking to create brave, compassionate, dedicated, firm, patriotic, and steady human beings through inculcation of a sense of *Aikya* (unity), *Anuśāsana* (discipline), *Dhairya* (patience), *Karuṇā* (compassion), *Satyānvēṣaṇa* (quest for truth), and *Śraddhā* (reverence) in learners. Thus, this unique academic institution will imbibe in the minds of learners such qualities as accountability, dedication, innovation, openness of mind, patriotism, scientific temper, social responsibility, and transparency.

1.6. BEST PRACTICES

The best practices of the University include its research and academic plans as well as a horizontal-cum-vertical model of incorporation of content from Bhāratīya Jñāna Paramparā or Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) in course curricula.

- a. **Research Plan:** Faculty members shall be encouraged to conduct research on different trending and important topics. All faculty members are to maintain a progress card of their research work. The Vice-Chancellor of the University shall monitor the progress of the research work by faculty once a week.
- b. **Academic Plan:** All faculty members shall regularly create comprehensive study materials for their classes. Faculty members are encouraged to implement the best pedagogies while delivering content for their classes. Every faculty member is to maintain a progress card of his/her teaching goals. The Vice-Chancellor of the University shall monitor the progress of teaching-learning activities by faculty once a week.
- c. **Bhāratīya Jñāna Paramparā (IKS) in curricula:** Every discipline's curriculum shall place sufficient emphasis on IKS. The course curriculum of every discipline shall include at least 5% of content about Bhāratīyatā, according to NEP, 2020. The implementation of IKS shall follow a horizontal-cum-vertical model in the curriculum: horizontal implementation of IKS will be in the form of introduction of subjects such as Bharat Bodh; vertical implementation shall come through incorporation of units/topics across discipline-specific courses in a way that establishes connections between the present-day corpus of knowledge and its parallels in IKS.

2.2. STRUCTURE OF UG & INTEGRATED PG PROGRAMMES

2.2.1. Existing Structure of FYUGP

- Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes (FYUGPs) consist of 8 semesters distributed across a duration of 4 years (2 semesters per year). A student can take a **major** in one discipline and two **minors** from other disciplines. However, at the end of the 2nd semester, a student can interchange the major with the minors. The major and the minor courses are drawn from a basket of disciplinary core courses. Other baskets of courses, as per the NEP, 2020, are **Multi-Disciplinary Courses (MDCs)**, **Ability Enhancement Courses (AECs)**, **Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs)**, **Value-Added Courses (VACs)**, **Vocational Courses (VOCs)**, and **Audit and Add-on Courses**.
- With 15 courses carrying 4 credits each, the major's is the longest thread. Minors' are relatively shorter threads of 4 courses, each carrying 4 credits. The major thread can be extended to the 4th year, that is, to the 7th and the 8th semesters, in order to earn an undergraduate degree with Honours or Honours with Research. In the case of Honours, this thread extends up to 23 courses.
- MDCs are relatively lightweight courses. They may be a short thread of three courses, each carrying 3 credits. A student can take these three courses from three different disciplines.
- Each course offered shall carry a specified credit depending upon the quantum of work involved in the course. One credit of a course implies the quantum of work done corresponding to 1 hour of a theory class (inclusive of classroom lectures and tutorials) or 2 hours of practical/fieldwork or 4 hours of research every week during a semester.

2.2.2. Proposed Structure of FYIPGP

(to be presented during upcoming Academic Council meeting in April 2024 for approval)

- Five-Year Integrated Postgraduate Programmes (FYIPGPs) are designed as per the NEP, 2020. **4-year UG + 1-year PG = 5-year PG**
- Here, a student can choose *any one* of the following three trajectories to earn a minimum of 40 credits:
 - a. Only coursework.
 - b. Coursework and research.
 - c. Only research.
- 40 credits are equivalent to 1,200 Notional Learning Hours (NLHs), as per the National Credit Framework (NCrF). Therefore, 1 credit is equivalent to 30 NLHs.
- The minimum credit points that a student must earn in order to be awarded a PG degree under the PG module is 260. Credit points are calculated by multiplying the total number of credits with the level value of 6.5, as per the NCrF. Credits can be assigned for experiential learning, as per the NCrF.

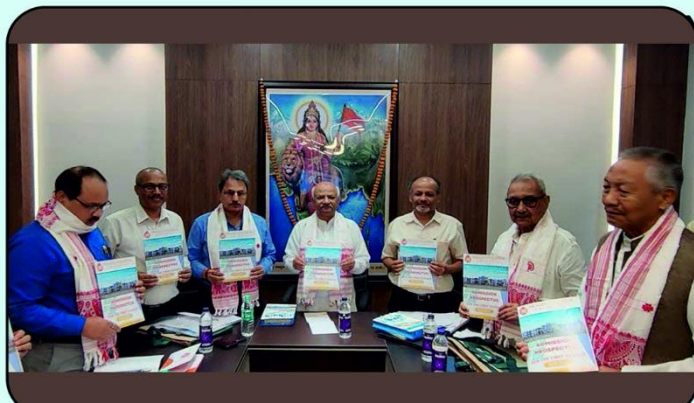

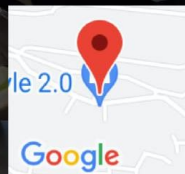

An internationally renowned scientist, Dr. Somanath led the team of scientists and engineers behind the successful Chandrayaan-3 mission of 2023 that helped India make history by becoming the first country to reach the moon's south pole. In September 2023, he and his team successfully launched India's first observation mission to the Sun, Aditya-L1.

Since the day of the programme coincided with Shilpi Divas, a lamp-lighting ceremony followed by garlanding of the image of the great artist Jyoti Prasad Agarwala formally opened the felicitation-cum-interaction programme.

Students from across schools and colleges in Assam witnessed Dr. Somanath speak on India's bold foray into space exploration. Noting that knowledge defines power today, he said that a nation has to be powerful to become capable of giving high standards of living to its citizens. Mentioning the Artificial Intelligence Revolution, he noted that social sensitivity must not be compromised in a world shaped and driven today by AI.

Responding to a student query on motivation in times of disappointment, Dr. Somanath remarked that in being grateful for what we have and learning to work with that gratitude, we do not need additional motivation. In this connection, he also said that power of mentorship makes ISRO great.

During the programme, alongside Dr. Somanath were other dignitaries: Chancellor of Pragjyotishpur University, Prof. Pradeep Kumar Joshi; Vice Chancellor of the University, Prof. Smriti Kumar Sinha; the University's Registrar, Prof. Jogesh Kakati; President of the Organising Committee, Prof. Parimal Chandra Bhattacharya; and Prof. (Dr.) Nani Gopal Mahanta, Advisor, Education, Government of Assam.
